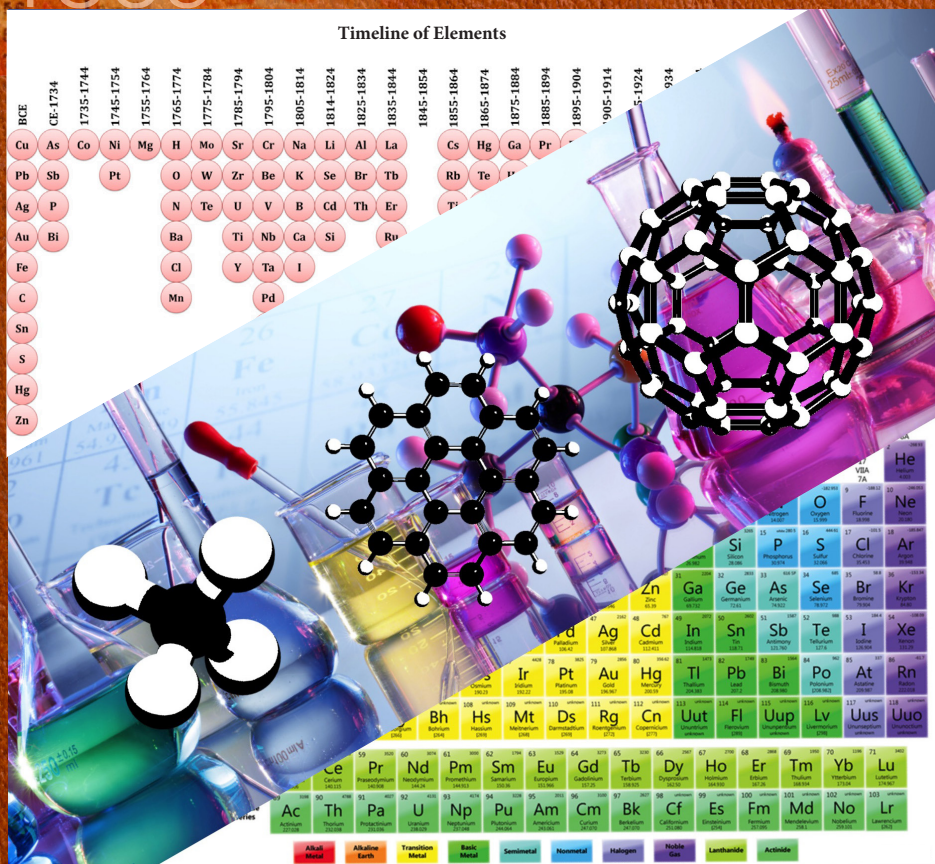

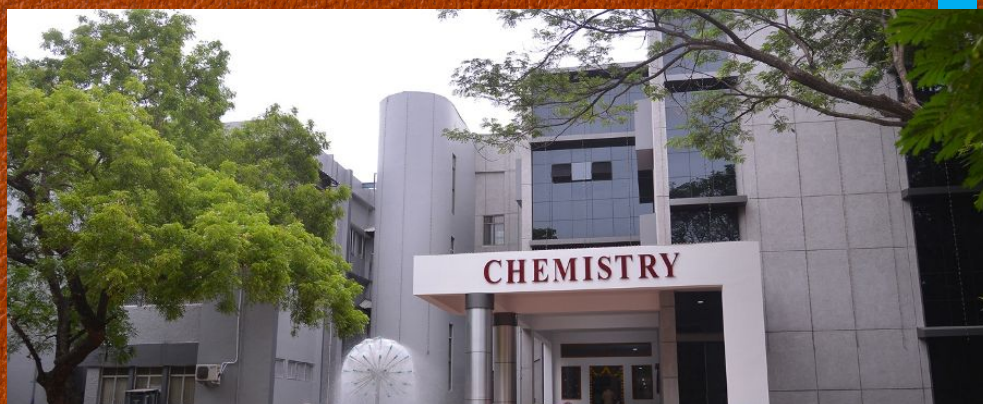
About CSIR-CLRI, Chennai

Registration

Abstract

Interested participants may submit an abstract of their original research work for poster presentation. Abstract template, the process of abstract submission, and poster size can be obtained from the conference website.

*IMPORTANT NOTE

The registration fee of Rs. 2000 is applicable to only those students who are currently members of the CRSI. If a student becomes a Life Member of the CRSI after paying Rs. 5000 (discounted fee), his/her registration fee will be waived for CRSI NSC-24, and for him/her only the accommodation fee of Rs. 500 per student per night will have to be paid.
